Slipway on site, for launching boats. No charge for guests staying at Romelda.






















KING BED, OUTDOOR BATH & SHOWER

To align with the peaceful surroundings, Romelda Lakeside Retreat features only six tents. These tents are harmoniously integrated into the natural landscape, nestled among trees and shrubs that provide privacy while maintaining breathtaking views of the garden.

Each tent includes a small private deck overlooking the lake. The spacious bedroom area comes with an open wardrobe and a modern, pristine en-suite bathroom. Thanks to the insulated canvas and additional shade roof, the tents remain cool during hot weather and warm on cooler days. Built-in mesh windows can be opened or closed to invite a refreshing lake breeze and allow guests to relish the sounds of nature.

ROMELDA MIDWATERS

Discover the Quaint and Quirky Romelda MidWaters Self-Catering Lodge located on the Mutirikwi River.

The lodge is situated on a private reserve, surrounded by lush Miombo woodlands and orchards, and offers an ideal getaway destination.



Access to MidWaters is via boat transfer from Romelda Lakeside Retreat, or by high-clearance/4X4 vehicle with more than 48h prior arrangement.

Boat transfers for arrivals are scheduled between 10:00 and 14:00.

If you need a transfer outside of this time frame, please make arrangements in advance.

MidWaters does not have back up electricity, but solar powered lights are provided as well as a generator to keep the fridge/freezers chilled. Please bring your own additional back-up power supplies.

BEDROOM EN-SUITE

The property consists of two separate lodges - Hippo and Zebra - each with two bedrooms, en-suite bathrooms, a kitchen, lounge, and dining area opening onto a raised deck which overlooks the lake and Glenlivet mountain range. Additionally, the property has two chalets - Buffalo and Bushbuck - that can each accommodate two extra guests and come with en-suite bathrooms and a private seating area or verandah.

Ideal for families or couples, the lodges offer a shared living space while maintaining privacy. For larger groups, exclusive property booking is available, allowing full access to the gardens and pool area.

ROOFTOP OR PITCH TENTS

A beautiful and serene lawned parkland, an oasis for campers. The shared ablution block facilities include solar geyser showers, flushing toilets, and a washing up and preparation area. The campsite area has braai facilities and picnic benches along the lakeshore for guests to enjoy the peaceful sights and sounds of the Lake.

For added convenience, Romelda Campsite provides three pre-assembled safari tents that are ideal for those seeking a luxurious camping experience. Each tent is furnished with a double bed, single bed and day bed that can be converted into an extra bed for a child. Additionally, the tents are equipped with small wardrobes for extra storage of personal items, solar fans and two small solar lights to keep you comfortable. Guests have access to shared ablution facilities and other camping amenities.

Access to the lodge facilities is not permitted, unless otherwise arranged with management.

GREAT ZIMBABWE NATIONAL MONUMENT

The ancient city of Great Zimbabwe is home to the country's oldest known buildings, constructed between 1100 and 1450 AD, and spread out over 800 hectares of land in three main sections: the Hill Ruins (Acropolis), the Valley Ruins, and the Great Enclosure.

Great Enclosure:

Elliptical structure with living quarters, a gathering area, and a conical tower, symbolizing Zimbabwe on currency and logos. It housed the king's family while soldiers monitored for threater.

Hill Ruins (Acropolis):

A granite hill with paths and viewing points, serving as a lookout for traders and intruders. Known as the "royal city," it displayed steatite posts topped with original Zimbabwe birds.

Valley Ruins:

Built in the 1800s, these ruins showcase advanced building styles with intricate wall decorations, representing the later Stone Ages.

ATTRACTIONS



The Italian Chapel of St. Francis of Assisi, located near the Masvingo Army Barracks, was built by Italian internees in the 1940s as a thank-you for refuge during World War II.

Visitors can explore its unique wall and ceiling paintings, and it serves as a burial site for Italian soldiers from a nearby prison camp.

Entrance is free, but donations to the caretakers are gratefully appreciated.



The Chamavara Caves are a hidden gem for exploring historical rock paintings, located 30km from Romelda Lakeside Retreat. A short drive followed by a 1km walk leads to the rock wall featuring layered graphics from various historical eras. Visitors can enjoy stunning views of the surrounding rural landscape, farmlands, and animal tracks, providing a glimpse into rich cultural history and beautiful scenery.



Located near the lodge, the Popoteke River offers stunning sunset views and scenic beauty. Following the river leads to a gorge with 70m rock faces, home to various bird species like Peregrin Falcons and African Harrier Hawks, as well as unique endemic aloes that bloom beautifully in August.



The Popoteke river also serves as a breeding ground for crocodiles, particularly visible from June to August when they sunbathe on the banks, allowing for observation in their natural habitat.



The Kyle Dam wall on Lake Mutirikwi, built in 1960, is a 48-meter high and 575-meter long concrete gravity dam in Masvingo Province, Zimbabwe. It provides water to surrounding areas and generates hydroelectric power.
















PAYMENT OPTIONS:

Cancellation fees will be charged depending on date of cancellation based on your proforma invoice total.


